Fernando Aguilar will discuss the project management aspects of the solar panel installation at AT&T Park. AT&T Park is the first Major League Baseball (MLB) ballpark with a solar system providing up to 120 kilowatts (kW) of clean renewable energy. The project, a joint partnership between the San Francisco Giants and Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E), includes 590 Sharp solar panels in three areas of AT&T Park -- on the Port Walk along McCovey Cove, on the newly erected canopy over the Willie Mays pedestrian ramp, and on the roof of the Giants Building.



Mr. Aguilar served as the project manager for the solar installation at AT&T Park and is currently a Senior Project Manager at Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E).
